
#### ORDER

**Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005**

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 01.04.2013 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against letter dated 19.03.2013 of CPIO, EIC in relation to information sought by him vide his application dated 26.12.2012.

Vide his letter dated 26.12.2012 filed with EIC, Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought information in respect of (1) court cases filed against EIC/EIAs by the landlords for vacations of their premises; (2) vacation of old office premises and occupation of new office premises & (3) proposals under consideration of premises to be vacated and hiring of new premises. All this information was desired in formats prescribed by him. In reply, vide his letter dated 19.03.2013, the CPIO, EIC had informed Shri Sakhuja that he was seeking open ended information without any time or period attached to it and that searching and providing such information would result in disproportionate diversion of meagre resources of the organisation in terms of section 7(9) of the RTI.

I have gone through the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja and I agree with the CPIO that searching of information for the entire life of the organisation would result in disproportionate diversion of meagre resources of the organisation. As there is no infirmity in CPIO invoking Section 7(9) of the RTI Act, the appeal filed by Shri Praveen Sakhuja stands disposed of with the advice that he should be specific while seeking information.
