ORDER


**Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005**

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 01.04.2013 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against letter dated 25.03.2013 of CPIO, EIC in relation to information sought by him vide his application dated 25.02.2013.

Vide his letter dated 25.02.2013, Shri Sakhuja had sought six information in relation to the posts that stood abolished in EIC & EIAs listed in recruitment rules of EIC/EIAs listed at the website of EIC. In reply, vide his letter dated 25.03.2013 the CPIO, EIC had informed Shri Sakhuja that the information sought is not clear.

I have gone through the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja and observe that Shri Sakhuja is not clear as to what he would like to know from the organisation. His queries – *posts stand abolished in Export Inspection Council / Agencies listed in recruitment rules of EIC / EIA's listed at website of EIC & date of falling vacant; date of abolishing for each post* are vague. Shri Sakhuja should remember that no organisation can disproportionately divert its resources for collecting / searching some vague information sought by an applicant and therefore, the applicant needs to be precise in seeking the information.

As there is no infirmity in the order passed by the CPIO, EIC, the appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja stands disposed of.
