### ORDER


**Subject: Appeal made by Shri B. C. Saxena under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005.**

Shri B. C. Saxena vide his letter dated 23.08.2011 has made an appeal under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against the decision dated 28.07.2011 of CPIO – EIC for intentionally concealing the information requested by him vide serial numbers 7, 8, 10 & 11 of his application dated 28.06.2011.

Vide his letter-dated 28.07.2011, Shri Saxena had requested for 11 number of information relating to employees who have resigned / opted voluntary retirement from EIC / EIAs since 01.01.2011. At serial number 7, Shri Saxena had asked for the date of relieving of the employee, which was mentioned as (i) 01.05.2011, (ii) 01.09.2011, (iii) 01.06.2011, (iv) 01.06.2011 and (v) 01.08.2011 respectively in respect of the 5 employees who had opted for voluntary retirement. The related information sought at serial number 8 to 11 was also provided by the CPIO. Shri Saxena has now contended that as the information was furnished to him on 28.07.2011, (ii) and (v) above should be considered as “not relieved” and as such, he has concluded that the CPIO has deliberately concealed the information.

I have gone through the appeal of Shri Saxena and letter dated 28.07.2011 of the CPIO and observe that the CPIO has informed him of the dates of relieving of the employees, as approved by the competent authority.

As there is no denial of information and the information, as it exists has been provided to Shri Saxena, the appeal made by Shri B. C. Saxena stands disposed off.
