### ORDER

**Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005**

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 14.03.2013 has made an appeal under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 to the CIC against letter dated 23.10.2012 of CPIO, EIA – Delhi in relation to information sought by him vide his application dated 24.09.2012.

Vide application-dated 24.09.2012, Shri Sakhuja had sought “details of working of officers from EIA – Delhi HQ to sub offices since January 2010 in tabled manner” and had prescribed a format for the same. In response, vide his letter dated 22.08.2012, the CPIO, EIA – Delhi had informed Shri Sakhuja that the information sought was voluminous and would result into diversion of meagre resources, invoking section 7 (9) of RTI Act.

I have gone through the appeal made by Shri Sakhuja and observe (i) that “details of working of officers from EIA – Delhi HQ to sub offices” is vague, (ii) that there appears to be no infirmity in the observation made by CPIO that searching of “number of visits to sub offices with periods” as per the format prescribed by Shri Sakhuja undertaken by 13 – 14 officers to 7 sub offices during a period of 2 years & nine months would result into diversion of meagre resources of the organisation and (iii) that Shri Sakhuja has not stated any larger public interest that the information sought by him is likely to serve.

Shri Sakhuja may recall that he has been advised number of times to be precise while seeking information under the RTI Act as no organisation can disproportionately divert the its resources in searching a voluminous information. Accordingly, no further instructions to CPIO are required in the matter.
