
ORDER

Subject: Appeal made under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 – compliance to directions issued by the CIC – reg.

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter-dated 27.04.2012 had requested the CPIO, EIA – Delhi for seven information related to seniority lists of employees, their circulation, utilisation in DPCs & MACP etc. in response, CPIO, EIA – Delhi had informed Shri Sakhuja that the information sought was voluminous and would result in diversion of meagre resources of the organisation in terms of section 7 (9) of the RTI Act. Not satisfied with the answer, the applicant has filed 2nd appeal dated 18.10.2012, demanding that CPIO should furnish the 7 information sought by him.

Now in compliance to CIC order (case no. CIC/SS/A/2012/003677), I have gone through the case papers and observe (i) that Shri Sakhuja is habitual of filing applications in a large number on almost any matter including administrative / service matters, (ii) that Shri Sakhuja was not specific while seeking the information, (iii) that primary responsibility of the organisation is to ensure efficient operations to generate revenue to pay for the salary of its employees and (iv) that for an organisation (EIA – Delhi) operating with around 66% of the sanctioned strength, I have no reasons to disagree with the contention of CPIO, EIA – Delhi that searching for vague information would result in diversion of its meagre resources.

Accordingly, the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja stands disposed of. Shri Sakhuja is also advised to be specific while seeking information and not to misuse his right to information as a tool for harassment of the department.
