### ORDER

**Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005**


Shri Praveen Sakhuja has filed seven appeals, all dated 16.01.2014 (received on 22.01.2014) under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against letter dated 02.12.2013 of CPIO, EIA - Delhi in relation to information sought by him vide his seven applications, 2 dated 29.11.2013 and five dated 02.12.2013.

On 02.12.2013, Shri Sakhuja had submitted 19 applications addressed to the CPIO, Export Inspection Council, New Delhi, with Export Inspection Agency - Delhi. These applications included reference number EIC - 13 - 146 & 147, both dated 29.11.2013 and EIC - 13 - 148, 149, 150, 151 & 152, all dated 02.12.2013. All 19 applications were returned back to Shri Sakhuja by CPIO, EIA - Delhi on 02.12.2013 itself, informing him that he should seek the information directly from EIC.

Shri Sakhuja has filed the appeals arguing that CPIO, EIA - Delhi should have transferred the RTI applications to CPIO, EIC as part of his duties under the RTI Act instead of advising him to approach CPIO, EIC.

I have gone through the appeal and observe that Shri Sakhuja was aware that the information being sought by him was available with EIC. Further, he was also aware of the address of the CPIO, EIC as he has been regularly addressing applications to EIC. The provision in the RTI Act for transfer of RTI applications to the concerned authorities has been made only for cases where the information seeker is not aware from where to seek the information.

In view of the above, I do not find any merit in the above mentioned seven identical appeals. The seven appeals filed by Shri Sakhuja stand disposed of.
