ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005

Facts of the Case:

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 31 March 2014 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, as he was not satisfied with the reply given by CPIOs to his RTI application request dated 12 Feb 2014 (EIC-14-010).

Vide his RTI request dated 12 Feb 2014 Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought information on the details where Dr S K Saxena Director EIC had acted as Resource Person. The information sought reads as:

The details of all such visits/ sessions attended by Dr S K Saxena as a resource person in a format

Travelling tour programmes approved by competent authority for such traveling

Settled travelling bills along with all supporting bills, documents submitted for claim settlement

CPIO EIC vide her letter dated 11 March 2014 replied to Shri Sakhuja stating that as per records maintained only one visit was made by Dr S K Saxena Director EIC. CPIO EIC vide her letter dated 24 April 2014 provided the copy of the notesheet as well to the applicant

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIOs the applicant raised an appeal under section 19(1) of RTI Act 2005 vide his letter dated 31 March 2014.

The issues raised in the appeal of the applicant are that the information provided is not complete and is delayed considerably and therefore the information should be provided to applicant free of cost.

Having gone through the appeal and replies given by the CPIOs, I am of the considered view that the applicant be provided with the information which exists as per provisions of Section 2 of RTI Act 2005. In the case instant the applicant had been supplied with the information available with the concerned section vide her communication dated 11 March 2014.

Since there was no further information on record the same cannot be provided and I find no reason to give any further direction to CPIO. A issue has been raised in appeal that the applicant be provided document, if any, free of cost as there is considerable delay in providing information. I note that CPIO EIC Delhi vide her communication dated 24 April 2014 had provided the copy of note-sheet free of cost and therefore there is no need to give any further directions in the matter

Orders:

I find no reason to give no further directions to CPIO as there is no denial of the information to the applicant.

This disposes off the appeal of Shri Praveen Sakhuja.
