ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Rajesh Mehta under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005

Facts of the Case:

Shri Rajesh Mehta vide his letter dated 13 June 2014 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, as he was not satisfied with the reply given by CPIOs to his RTI application request dated 12 May 2014.

Vide his RTI request dated 12 May 2014 Shri Rajesh Mehta had sought information on the various facets of export of honey etc including issue of show cause to company, penalty levied etc in cases of unauthorized honey.

CPIO EIA Delhi vide his letter dated 5 June 2014 denied the information citing section 8 (1) (g) of RTI Act 2005 citing that the applicant is the top functionary in an export unit involved in export of honey. EIA Delhi had in recent past served the unit with a show cause in the matter of violation of notification of Govt of India and it was perceived by CPIO EIA Delhi an attempt to derail the investigations proceedings against the unit.

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIOs the applicant raised an appeal under section 19(1) of RTI Act 2005 vide his letter dated 12 May 2014.

The issues raised in the appeal of the applicant had not been provided with the information from CPIO EIC Delhi and as such there is an intentional denial on part of CPIO by concealing the information. By this RTI the applicant had desired to unearth the corrupt and red tapism prevailing in EIA Delhi.

Having gone through the appeal and replies given by the CPIOs, I am of the view that the RTI request of the applicant has sought information which was being investigated upon in reference with unauthorized export of Honey by units in violation of notification no SO 276 and 277 both dated 4 March 2002. In view of the submissions made by the applicant in his appeal following directions are given

Orders:

There is no infirmity in the actions of CPIO EIA Delhi and there is no further directions required in the matter
