Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act 2005.

Facts of the Case:

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 16 September 2015 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, against his RTI application request dated 14 August 2015.

Vide his RTI application dated 14 August 2015; Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought the information regarding details related to charge sheet issued to applicant.

CPIO, EIC vide letter dated 2 September 2015 informed applicant that he has been using RTI Act as a tool of vendetta for setting personal scores with the organization and unnecessary harassing the scarce resources of the organization. CPIO, EIC also informed to applicant that considering the misuse of RTI Act by him, this organization is no longer in position to fulfil the indiscriminate and impractical demands of all sundry information requested by him.

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIO, EIC the applicant has raised an appeal under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act 2005 vide his letter dated 16 September 2015.

The applicant, in his appeal, has requested to provide the information as requested.

CPIO, EIC has preferred not to raise any comment on the appeal of the applicant as they have already informed the applicant about misuse of RTI Act by him and they state that they have nothing to append.

Having gone through the appeal and the reply by CPIO, EIC, I am of the considered view that the applicant has been filing RTI applications in large numbers and using RTI Act as a tool of vendetta for setting personal scores with the organization.

Orders:

I find no infirmity in the reply of CPIO, EIC and therefore dispose the appeal without any further directions to CPIO, EIC.

This disposes off the appeal of Shri Praveen Sakhuja.
