ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act 2005.

Facts of the Case:

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 28th January, 2016 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, against his RTI application request dated 29 May, 2015.

Vide his RTI application dated 29th May, 2015; Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought the information regarding details of journey of Director, EIC in official staff car since October, 2009.

CPIO, EIC-Delhi vide letter dated 18th June, 2015 informed applicant that the information sought is voluminous, runs into various registers/ vouchers and compilation/ collation of the same would involve diversion of resources of the organization in terms of section 7 (9) of the RTI Act. Therefore, applicant was advised to carry out inspection of the tour register. On any working day with 7 days advance notice.

Further applicant vide letter dated 01st July, 2015 proposed for inspection on 07th July, 2015.

CPIO, EIC vide letter dated 06th July, 2015 informed applicant that due to administrative exigencies, inspection could not offered on 07th July, 2015 and the fresh date for inspection would be communicated separately.

Further applicant vide letter dated 28th September, 2015 proposed for inspection on 09th October, 2015.

CPIO, EIC-Delhi vide letter dated 12 October 2015 informed the applicant that he has been vindictive in using RTI Act as a tool of vendetta for setting personal scores with the organization and unnecessary harassing the scarce resources of the organization. CPIO, EIC-Delhi also informed to applicant that considering the misuse of RTI Act by him, this organization is no longer in position to fulfil the indiscriminate and impractical demands of all sundry information requested by him.

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIO, EIC-Delhi the applicant has raised an appeal under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act 2005 vide his letter dated 28th January, 2016.
