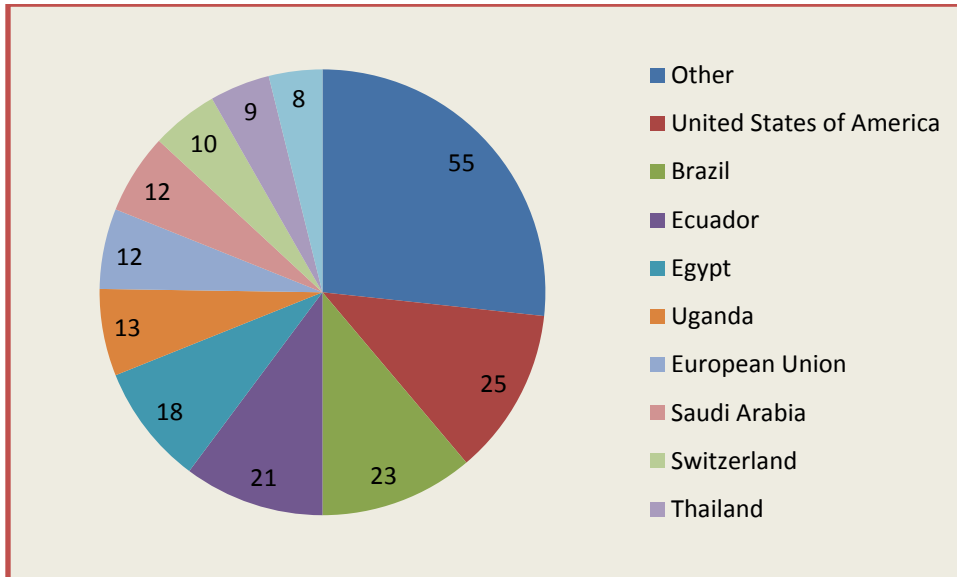

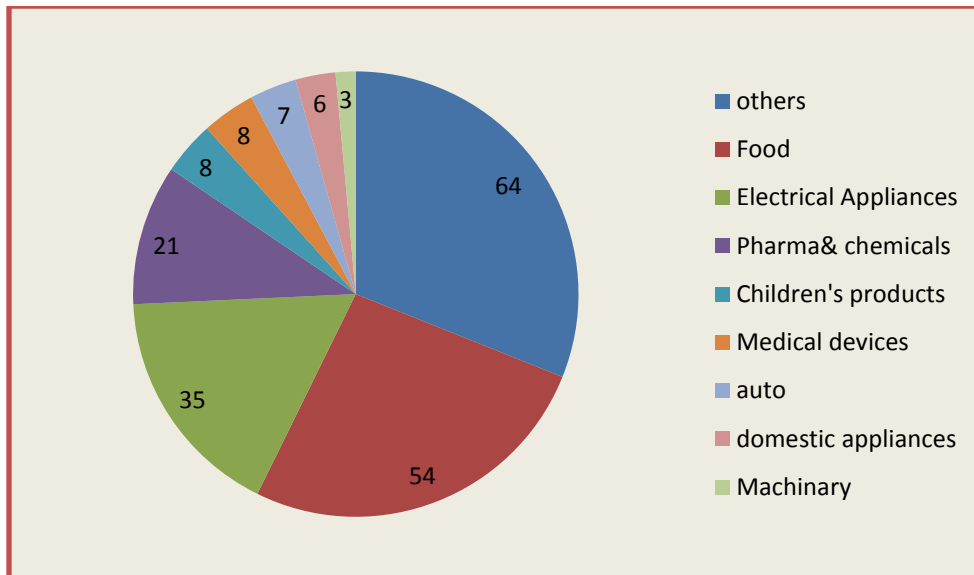

Notification Details:

The total numbers of TBT Notifications issued by various WTO-Member Countries in March 2015 were 206. Out of 206 notifications, 62 notifications were the adoption of draft regulations notified earlier in the WTO.

Product-wise Information: Out of the total 206 Notifications, 54 were related to food products, 21 related to pharmaceutical and chemical products, 7 related to Auto products, 35 related to electrical products, 8 related to medical devices, 8 related to children's products, 6 related to domestic appliances and 3 related to machinery and the remaining 64 Notifications were related to other products.

Country-wise Information: Out of the total 206 notifications, United States of America issued 25 notifications, followed by Brazil, Ecuador, Egypt, Uganda, European Union, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, Thailand and Mexico with 23, 21, 18, 13, 12, 12, 10, 9 and 10 Notifications, respectively. The remaining 55 Notifications were from other WTO Member countries.

Request for relevant Regulations/translated copies sent to the issuing countries:

We have sent request for regulations/translated copies for 56 Notifications. The responses were received from Korea, Egypt, Thailand and Saudi Arabia. However, the responses from the rest of the countries are awaited.
