ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri B. C. Saxena under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

Shri B. C. Saxena vide his letter dated 26.07.2011 has made an appeal under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against the decision dated 18.07.2011 of CPIO, EIA – Delhi for not providing complete information requested by him vide his application dated 20.06.2011.

Vide his application-dated 20.06.2011, Shri Saxena had requested for following information:

- How many times Shri Parameswaram has applied for earned leave during his tenure of stay in EIA – Delhi till date, kindly provide certified copies of the leave applications filed.
- Kindly provide certified copies of leave sanction memo for the EL applied by Shri Parameswaram for the above periods.


I have gone through the records and observe that whereas, there is no employee by the name of “Parameswaram” in EIA – Delhi, following information relating to Shri S. S. Parameswaran, a retired employee of EIA – Delhi was furnished to Shri Saxena by the CPIO, EIA – Delhi.

- The periods for which Shri Parameswaran had applied for and was granted earned leave, and
- Copies of leave sanction memo relating to 1 above.

The CPIO, EIA – Delhi had also informed Shri Saxena that the copies of leave application can not be supplied to him as they contain personal information. As there has not been any objection from Shri Saxena for receiving information relating to “Parameswaran” instead of “Parameswaram”, it is presumed that Shri Saxena was primarily interested in information related to “Parameswaran”.

I have gone through the appeal of Shri Saxena and the reply of the CPIO, EIA – Delhi and observe that the required information has been furnished by CPIO, EIA – Delhi to Shri Saxena. I also do not find any infirmity in the denial by CPIO of copies of leave applications (under section 8 (1) (j) of the RTI Act) as they contain personal information having no relationship to any public activity or interest. At the same time, it is observed that the applicant is also interested in the dates on which the leave applications were filed, which has not been furnished to him.

The CPIO, EIC, is therefore directed to provide Shri Saxena, within 15 days of receipt of this order, the details of dates on which the leave applications related to the four periods listed in para 2 of letter dated 18.07.2011 of CPIO, EIA – Delhi were filed by Shri Parameswaran.
