ORDER


Subject: Appeal made under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 – compliance to directions issued by the CIC – reg.

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 18.10.2012 has made an appeal to the Central Information Commission against the Export Inspection Agency – Delhi for not providing physical copy of information requested by him vide his application dated 12.04.2012.

Shri Sakhuja, vide letter-dated 12.04.2012, had sought 3 (three) information – (i) rule that declares Joint Director as the disciplinary authority; (ii) powers of Joint Director to appoint IO & PO and (iii) details of past cases indicating who had appointed IO & PO in those cases. In response, the CPIO, EIA – Delhi vide his letter-dated 11.05.2012 had informed Shri Sakhuja that the first two information were available at the website www.eicindia.gov.in and that the third information was voluminous and would result into diversion of meagre resources of the organisation. Shri Sakhuja has preferred an appeal insisting that the document referred to at the website be provided to him in physical form along with the third information.

Now in compliance to CIC order (case no. CIC/SS/A/2012/003671), I have gone through the case papers and observe (i) that Shri Sakhuja is habitual of filing applications in a large number on almost any matter including administrative / service matters; (ii) that CPIO, EIA – Delhi has provided him the link where the information is available; (iii) that physical copy of the Export Inspection Agency Employees (Classification Control & Appeal) Rules, 1978 was provide to Shri Sakhuja on more than one occasion and (iv) that even for searching the information, resources are committed and costs incurred by the department.

Accordingly, the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja stands disposed of. Shri Sakhuja is also advised to be specific while seeking information and not to misuse his right to information as a tool for harassment of the department as well as the CIC.
