ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005


Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 04.03.2013 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against letter dated 25.02.2013 of CPIO, EIC in relation to information sought by him vide his application dated 23.01.2013.

Vide his application-dated 23.01.2013, Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought 8 information's relating to 8 officers of different Export Inspection Agencies, namely (i) post and date on which appointed (ii) date of advertisement against which appointed (iii) date of joining in EIA stating region and office (iv) qualification possessed at the time of joining (v) qualification required for the post (vi) number of trainings attended at national level stating subject of training and amount spent on each participant (vii) number of trainings attended at international level stating subject of training and amount spent on each participant & (viii) place (s) of posting at which worked from date of joining till date. Shri Sakhuja had also requested for the copy of the advertisement against which the officers were recruited.

In reply vide his letter-dated 25.02.2013, the CPIO, EIC had furnished available information to Shri Sakhuja, though in a different format. He had also informed Shri Sakhuja that wherever information has not been provided, it is because searching of information would have involved diversion of meagre resources of the organisation concerned in terms of Section 7(9) of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Shri Sakhuja has filed a present application contending that the information required by him is easily available.

I have gone through the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja and the case papers and observe (i) that the information that was readily available has been provided to Shri Sakhuja, (ii) that Shri Sakhuja was informed clearly that providing balance of the information would seriously divert the resources of the organisation and (iii) that Shri Sakhuja is habitual in filing applications in a large number on any matter, misusing his Right to Information.

As there is no denial of information, the appeal filed by Shri Sakhuja stands disposed of. Shri Sakhuja is also advised not to misuse his Right to Information as a tool for harassing the organisation.
