ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005

Facts of the Case:

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 19 May 2014 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, as he was not satisfied with the reply given by CPIOs to his RTI application request dated 10 March 2014 (EIA-14-011).

Vide his RTI request dated 10 March 2014 Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought information on the certified copies of the service book. The information sought reads as:

The applicant requests for providing certified copy of the entire service book of self (Praveen Sakhuja who joined as JSA in EIA Delhi) while he was in service from Sept 1975 till date along with all supporting documents i.e. declarations, authorization undertaking and others if any.

The CPIO EIA Delhi vide his letter dated 18 March 2014 offered to Shri Sakhuja to carry out the inspection of the concerned file on any day with a notice of three day to EIA Delhi

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIOs the applicant raised an appeal under section 19(1) of RTI Act 2005 vide his letter dated 19 May 2014 and stated that he be provided the certified copy and he would undertake inspection thereafter if required

The issues raised in the appeal of the applicant are that it is deliberate on part of CPIO EIA Delhi in not providing the certified copies of the service records.

Having gone through the appeal and replies given by the CPIOs, I am of the considered view that the information sought by the applicant is available in the office and the same has been offered to the applicant by offering inspection. Thus there being no infirmity in the actions of CPIO and there is no reasons to believe that the information has either been concealed or obstructed.

Orders:

There is no infirmity in decision of CPIO and hence no orders given to CPIO EIA Delhi. However it is open for the applicant to cite a specific document which he would need and CPIO shall provide the same to the applicant

This disposes off the appeal of Shri Praveen Sakhuja.
