ORDER

Subject: Appeal made by Shri Praveen Sakhuja under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005

Facts of the Case:

Shri Praveen Sakhuja vide his letter dated 19 May 2014 has made an appeal under Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act 2005, as he was not satisfied with the reply given by CPIOs to his RTI application request dated 3 March 2014 (EIA-14-003).

Vide his RTI request dated 3 March 2014 Shri Praveen Sakhuja had sought information on the certificate of origin signed by various officers, their reason for rejection etc in the month of Jan 2014.

The CPIO EIA Delhi vide his letter dated 5 March 2014 offered to Shri Sakhuja to have on payment of required fees take the information but the information on forms rejected their reasoning since it is not maintained would not be available in the sheet.

Aggrieved by the reply of CPIOs the applicant raised an appeal under section 19(1) of RTI Act 2005 vide his letter dated 19 May 2014 and stated that the CPIO has not provided the information and hence he be directed to provide the same to applicant

The issues raised in the appeal of the applicant are that it is deliberate on part of CPIO EIA Delhi in not providing the certified copies and the documents.

Having gone through the appeal and replies given by the CPIOs, I am of the considered view that the information sought by the applicant as available in the office was offered and the same has been offered to the applicant by CPIO after payment of due charges. Thus there being no infirmity in the actions of CPIO and there are no reasons to believe that the information has either been concealed or obstructed.

There is no infirmity in decision of CPIO and hence no further directions are required in the matter.
